Sanctioned as a clinic by the North American Trail Ride Conference, the "C" Introductory Ride is geared to introduce new competitors to the sport of competitive trail riding. It is being held in conjunction with the Jackson Forest NATRC ride in the beautiful redwood forests of Jackson State Forest.

You can check in the same day as the ride (although you're welcome to camp overnight the night before), complete the ride by early afternoon and check out the same day. Stabling will not be judged. A short ride briefing will be held prior to the ride. The NATRC rules for hoof and leg protection will not be applied to the introductory ride. There are no shoeing restrictions. You will receive a scorecard for you to learn about judging criteria, however you will not accrue mileage nor will the ride be eligible for end of year awards.

Horses must be 4 years or older. The ride will be 8-12 miles at a 3-4 mph pace (a brisk and steady walk).

Tentative Schedule:

8:30 am	Check-in with the ride secretary
9:30 am	Present horse (untacked) for preliminary examination
10:30 am	Ride briefing
11:30 am	Time out
2:30 – 3:00 pm	Back in camp
4 pm	Present horse for final examination
6 pm	Dinner.

REGULATIONS: A saddle is required on the ride, but there are no restrictions on type. Hay or other feed is not available for purchase. Stallions must be double tied and ridden only by an adult. After 10:00 p.m., all should be quiet so we can rest for the next day's ride. Dogs must be on leash and well behaved; absolutely no loose or noisy dogs.

All minors under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult in camp and management strongly suggests juniors be accompanied by an adult on the trail.

ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING ON THE TRAIL. Water will be available for horses in camp; bring your own to drink, the camp has no potable water. Camp is far from stores, so bring necessary food and supplies with you. There are no hookups, but toilet facilities are available. Manure must be placed in the dump trailer provided

Directions: Go north on 101 from the city of Ukiah for about 15 miles, take the Highway 20 off-ramp into the town of Willits. At the 3rd stoplight turn west on Hwy 20 and proceed west approximately 17 miles on a scenic winding highway. Watch for a sign stating "horse camp" on your right and the historic Little Red Schoolhouse on your left. **Continue on** over a bridge and turn left into the Jackson Forest Day Use area – MAKE A U TURN THERE and head back west over the bridge. Turn right onto the forest service road, and left again on the first gravel road. Camp is ¾ mile on the left. There is no real GPS address, if you need to use a GPS put in the address 15800 State Highway 20, Fort Bragg Ca. That is the Chamberlain Creek Conservation Camp – the U Turn is right across from that. There is very little phone service in the camp so you can't call into camp. If you are arriving on Friday or Saturday we will have the turns well marked.

RIDER LIABILITY WAIVER

The following must be signed and dated for entry to be valid:

"I WISH to enter and participate in the Jackson Forest Introductory Ride Competitive Trail Ride, to be held at
Fort Bragg Ca _____ on August 18th 2018.

"I HAVE READ the rules, conditions, and regulations of the event and will comply with them. I AGREE to abide by the rules of the North American Trail Ride Conference and the aforementioned ride. I UNDERSTAND that competitive riding is a high risk activity, which involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, far from communications, transportation, and medical facilities; that these areas have many natural and/or man made hazards which ride management cannot anticipate, identify, modify, or eliminate; that horses can be excitable, difficult to control and unpredictable; that personal belongings can be damaged, lost, or stolen, and that accidents can happen to anyone at any time.

I AGREE to assume all risks associated with my participation in this activity, and I accept full responsibility for myself and the animal I am riding. As a condition precedent to my being allowed to participate in this activity, I agree that I WILL NOT SUE OR BRING ANY CLAIM AGAINST THE NORTH AMERICAN TRAIL RIDE CONFERENCE, ITS DIRECTORS AND/OR OFFICERS, RIDE MANAGEMENT, RIDE PERSONNEL, VOLUNTEERS, PROPERTY OWNERS WHERE EVENT TAKES PLACE, AND/OR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS THEREOF, (HEREAFTER REFERRED TO AS "THE RELEASED PARTIES") FOR ANY INJURY, ACCIDENT, DEATH AND/OR LOSS OF ANY KIND WHICH ARISES OUT OF THIS EVENT, AND WILL INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASED PARTIES FROM ALL LIABILITY FOR SUCH INJURY, ACCIDENT, DEATH OR LOSS, EVEN IF SUCH INJURY, ACCIDENT, DEATH AND/OR LOSS ARISES FROM THE ALLEGED NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASED PARTIES. Junior riders must wear an ASTM/SEI, Snell, or approved equal equestrian riding helmet at all times while mounted.

To the extent any dispute arises out of this agreement, the parties agree to submit said dispute to binding arbitration before a neutral arbitrator mutually selected by the parties, said arbitration to be conducted in accordance with the Rules of the American Arbitration Association. All such arbitrations shall be held in the county or district where NATRC National headquarters are located. If the prevailing party, NATRC shall be allowed to recover all costs and expenses incurred, including attorney's fees and costs. - (b) The unpredictability of an equine’s reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, person, or other animals;
- (c) Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions;
- (d) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object;
- (e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.
