The day will begin by introducing to you the sport of distance competitive trail riding, as sanctioned by the North American Trail Ride Conference. Experienced competitors and Region 1 board members will be the presenters who will show you how a typical ride is run, discuss what judges may look for, and explain the focus on education, safety, and helping your horse succeed over long distances. Each participant will be coached through the normal steps of a day of competition, directed by our volunteers. The intro ride will involve 8-10 miles of riding. Scores for both horse and rider will be given, and the scorecards will be sent home with you. By the end of this clinic you will have a feel for the sport and know what to expect at a competition at any of the rides offered in our region.
