

Cool Canyon NATRC Ride-B1 (One Day) Ride for ALL Divisions

Saturday, October 26, 2024

LeD(only) Rider limit = 25

Auburn State Recreation Area, Cool, California

This ride takes place through the Auburn State Recreation Area (ASRA) trails, outside of Auburn, California. It consists of single track and fire roads through the heart of historic California Gold Country. The ride is sanctioned by the North American Trail Ride Conference (NATRC) and will be conducted under the rules as published in the 2024 NATRC Rule Book

Leisure Riders may camp over Friday night or arrive early Saturday morning for their ride at Cool Hills Ranch. *If parking is full Saturday morning at Cool Hills Ranch, Leisure riders will stage out of the Cool Equestrian staging area, and need to plan their timing to ride down to Cool Hills Ranch for the morning's ride briefing and check in.*

Open, Novice and CP riders will camp and stage out of the Cool Hills Ranch, a private facility very close to the Cool Equestrian Staging area. Open, Novice, CP Riders please arrive no later than 3 pm Friday as a courtesy to the judges who will be checking you in Friday afternoon. If you're arriving late, notify ride management. Park in designated parking spots (they will be assigned by rig size due to limited camping space) Include your full rig length (truck+trailer) on your registration form. ****Try to share your trailer with a friend to save space** Priority will be given to those with multiple horses in their trailers.**

B1 = Saturday one day ride

Open "B1" ride will be approximately 28-30 miles

Novice/CP "B1" ride will be approximately 18-22 miles.

Leisure "B1" ride will be approximately 10-12 miles.

The OPEN Division (Adult and Junior classes) is timed for a well-conditioned horse that can trot evenly on the flat and walk fast up and down hills. Equines must be 5 years or older

Competitive Pleasure (CP) (Adult and Junior classes) is timed for experienced competitors who are no longer eligible for or choose not to compete in the Novice Division but do not wish to advance to the faster pace and distance of Open. Equines must be 4 years of age.

Novice (Adult and Junior classes) is timed at a brisk and steady walk. Equines must be 4 years of age.

Leisure Division is timed at a brisk and steady walk and consists of Adult, Junior and Experienced classes. Equines must be 4 years of age.

Junior Riders must wear an ASTM/SEI, Snell, or approved equestrian helmet at all times while mounted. It is recommended that adults also wear helmets.

Registration Fees Include: all judges' fees, ride insurance, sanction fees, NATRC rider fees, CA drug testing fees (\$14.00 per horse as of July 2022), ASRA park permit fees and awards.

Cancellations: Entry fee will be refunded except for a \$10 administrative fee when received by **October 23rd**
Late cancellations can be approved by management if due to medical issues or extenuating circumstances.
No refund if you are a No show.

Awards presented for 1st through 6th place in each class as well as Highpoint Award (LeD) and Sweepstakes.

Registration is NOT complete until NATRC, CA and Cool Hills Ranch waivers are signed and provided to management along with payment. Waivers are attached. Return by mail with the entry form. If you enter via RMS, you still must mail the waivers to ride management and submit payment prior to the ride unless arrangements have been made with ride management to pay at the ride.

Notes-Please read

1. You are in competition from the time you present your horse at check in until check back after the ride is completed. O/CP/N try to arrive by 3pm Friday to check in, unless arrangements are made with ride management. A saddle with stirrups is required but there are no restrictions as to type. Stallions must be double tied and only ridden by an adult. After 10 pm-QUIET TIME for campers.
2. In camp, horses will be trailer tied in accordance with NATRC rules. High Ties are OK. There is not enough room at either camping site for portable corrals.
3. Water is available for horses. Bring your own people water. Hay is not available for purchase at the ride.
4. All Juniors under 18 are required to wear an ASTM/SEI, Snell or approved riding helmet at all times when mounted. Minors must be accompanied by an adult in camp. Riders 12 and under must ride with an adult sponsor or a junior sponsor 13 or older with more than 250 NATRC miles. Management strongly suggests all juniors be accompanied by an adult on the trail.
5. All juniors must have a liability waiver signed by a parent or legal guardian. Return signed waiver with entry by mail or bring to the ride. **Juniors cannot ride without the signed waivers. No exceptions.**
6. RIDERS AND VOLUNTEERS MUST SIGN all Liability Waiver(s) to participate in this ride.
7. Camping is at a Cool Hills ranch with limited space for rigs. Priority given to rigs with 2 or more horses in them. Call, text or email Erin McChesney for updated camping availability-we need the size of your rig, and number of horses in it as well as who you are trailering with. The Cool Hills Ranch camping fees are listed on the entry form.
8. Well behaved dogs can be on leash at trailers only at the ASRA staging area. No dogs allowed at ride briefings, in the horse presentation area or on the trails. This is a requirement from the ride insurance company. Please comply. ****Note that Cool Hills Ranch is a private boarding facility and the owner has requested no dogs allowed for this event for the safety of her boarders. Please note if you are camping or parking at Cool Hills Ranch****
9. **Be sure your equine is up to date on vaccinations and deworming for everyone's safety**

Be aware that all competitive rides are subject to random drug testing by the State of California. They may collect either urine or blood specimens. Ride entry denotes agreement to State testing if necessary.

Directions :

To Cool Hills Ranch: From Interstate 80, take Hwy 49 exit (Elm St. exit 119C) toward Placerville. Turn LEFT on High Street and follow signs to Highway 49 South. Stay on Highway 49 South (it's a winding road) for 2 miles, then turn RIGHT at the bridge to Cool (4 miles). Proceed to stop sign, go straight ~3/4 mile. Barn/facility entrance on the right (look for covered arena) Watch for the pink/yellow ribbons indicating the turn into Cool Hills Ranch.

To Cool Hills Ranch: From Hwy 50 (better for large rigs)** take Exit #37 Ponderosa/Shingle Springs. From Hwy 50 West, go left over the freeway. From Hwy 50 East, go right over the freeway). The first RIGHT once you cross over the freeway is N. Shingles Springs Rd. Continue on this two-lane road until you reach Lotus where it will dead end into Hwy 49. Turn Left on Hwy 49. Continue 12 miles to Cool. Cool Hills Ranch will be on the left, just past Northside School and Cool Church. Use second entrance by the covered arena. Watch for the pink/yellow ribbons indicating the turn into Cool Hills Ranch.

For Saturday overflow parking (at the ASRA Cool Staging Lot): From Interstate 80, take Hwy 49 exit (Elm St. exit 119C) toward Placerville. Turn LEFT on High Street and follow signs to Highway 49 South. Stay on Highway 49 South (it's a winding road) for 2 miles, then turn RIGHT at the bridge to Cool (4 miles). For those using GPS, use Saint Florian Dr., Cool, CA and it should take you there. The staging area is off Saint Florian Court behind the Cool Fire Station, Turn RIGHT on 7200 Saint Florian Court , staging area is slightly past the fire station. Vehicles without a horse trailer must park in the car parking area.

For Saturday overflow parking (at the ASRA Cool Staging Lot) From Highway 50 (better for large rigs): take Exit #37 Ponderosa/Shingle Springs. From Hwy 50 West, go left over the freeway. From Hwy 50 East, go right over the freeway). The first RIGHT once you cross over the freeway is N. Shingles Springs Rd. Continue on this two-lane road until you reach Lotus where it will dead end into Hwy 49. Turn Left on Hwy 49. Continue 12 miles to Cool, then left on Florian (by the fire station) and a few hundred feet until the staging area. Vehicles without a horse trailer must park in the car parking area.

If you have a Poppy Pass and park at the ASRA Cool Staging lot, post the pass on your vehicle window so that it's visible.

If you need a parking pass, they will be available at the Cool Hills Ranch registration table.

Volunteers: day parking fees for Cool Hills Ranch or ASRA staging area will be paid by Cool ride management. Pick up a parking voucher at the registration desk and make sure it's visible in your vehicle window.

RIDER LIABILITY WAIVER

The following must be signed and dated for entry to be valid:

"I WISH to enter and participate in the Cool Canyon NATRC Ride Competitive Trail Ride, to be held at Auburn State Recreation Area on October 26, 2024 (date)". "I HAVE READ the rules, conditions, and regulations of the event and will comply with them. I AGREE to abide by the rules of the North American Trail Ride Conference and the aforementioned ride. I UNDERSTAND that competitive riding is a high risk activity, which involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, far from communications, transportation, and medical facilities; that these areas have many natural and/or man-made hazards which ride management cannot anticipate, identify, modify, or eliminate; that horses can be excitable, difficult to control and unpredictable; that personal belongings can be damaged, lost, or stolen, and that accidents can happen to anyone at any time.

I AGREE to assume all risks associated with my participation in this activity, and I accept full responsibility for myself and the animal I am riding. As a condition precedent to my being allowed to participate in this activity, I agree that I WILL NOT SUE OR BRING ANY CLAIM AGAINST THE NORTH AMERICAN TRAIL RIDE CONFERENCE, ITS DIRECTORS AND/OR OFFICERS, RIDE MANAGEMENT, RIDE PERSONNEL, VOLUNTEERS, PROPERTY OWNERS WHERE EVENT TAKES PLACE, AND/OR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS THEREOF, (HEREAFTER REFERRED TO AS "THE RELEASED PARTIES") FOR ANY INJURY, ACCIDENT, DEATH AND/OR LOSS OF ANY KIND WHICH ARISES OUT OF THIS EVENT, AND WILL INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS THE RELEASED PARTIES FROM ALL LIABILITY FOR SUCH INJURY, ACCIDENT, DEATH OR LOSS, EVEN IF SUCH INJURY, ACCIDENT, DEATH AND/OR LOSS ARISES FROM THE ALLEGED NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASED PARTIES. I HEREBY CERTIFY THAT MY HORSE IS NOT UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF MEDICATION AND WILL NOT BE TREATED WITH OR GIVEN ANY MEDICATION PROHIBITED BY NATRC™ RULES. I HEREBY GIVE PERMISSION TO THE NORTH AMERICAN TRAIL RIDE CONFERENCE OR THEIR DULY APPOINTED AGENT, TO TAKE ANY APPROPRIATE ACTION DEEMED NECESSARY TO CHECK FOR POSSIBLE ADMINISTRATION OF DRUGS TO MY HORSE."

Junior riders must wear an ASTM/SEI, Snell, or approved equal equestrian riding helmet at all times while mounted.

To the extent any dispute arises out of this agreement, the parties agree to submit said dispute to binding arbitration before a neutral arbitrator mutually selected by the parties, said arbitration to be conducted in accordance with the Rules of the American Arbitration Association. All such arbitrations shall be held in the county or district where NATRC National headquarters are located. If the prevailing party, NATRC shall be allowed to recover all costs and expenses incurred, including attorney's fees and costs. **"MY SIGNATURE BELOW CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THE ABOVE TERMS AND CONDITIONS. I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTOOD THIS LIABILITY RELEASE AND BINDING ARBITRATION CLAUSE."**

- (d) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object;
- (e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.

HORSE RIDING INDEMNITY AND LIABILITY RELEASE FORM

HORSEBACK RIDING CAN BE DANGEROUS SERIOUS INJURY MAY RESULT FROM YOUR PARTICIPATION IN THIS ACTIVITY

Hereinafter referred to as "I" and Cool Hills Ranch, hereinafter referred to as "Cool Hills Ranch" of 3320 Hwy 49, Cool, CA 95614.

It is hereby agreed to as follows:

1. HAZARDOUS ACTIVITY: I understand that horseback riding is a hazardous activity and that horses are unpredictable by nature; that when frightened or angry or under stress, a horse's natural instincts are to jump forward or sideways, to run away from danger at a trot, canter, or gallop, to kick, to buck, to rear up in front, or to bite; that horses are extremely powerful; and that if a rider falls to the ground, the fall distance will generally be more than 5 feet. I understand that these risks and voluntarily assume these risks and dangers for myself or on behalf of my child or legal ward. I further expressly agree that the forgoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement are intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by law of the State of California and if any portion thereof is held invalid it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect. _____(Initial here)

2. RIDING HELMETS: I understand that I can better protect myself against head injuries by wearing protective equestrian head gear while mounting, riding, dismounting and being around horses. I accept full responsibility for the increased risk of injury if I decide not to wear a helmet or not to require my child or legal ward to wear a helmet. _____(Initial here)

3. LIABILITY RELEASE: I understand that, except in the event of Cool Hills Ranch wanton or willful negligence, I am responsible for bodily injury or property damage that I or my child or legal ward should sustain while riding a horse. I am also responsible for medical expenses or any other expense incurred as a result of such bodily injury or property damage. I am responsible for any time I, or my child or legal ward shall lose in employment or school or other activity. I hereby for myself, my heirs, administrators and assigns release and discharge Cool Hills Ranch (John and Cristine Grey) from claims, demands, actions, and causes of action for such injuries sustained to my person, or that of my child or legal ward and/or my property. _____(Initial here)

4. INDEMNITY: I hereby agree to indemnify, save and hold harmless, each of them from loss, liability, damage pay any expenses, loss or damage that is incurred due to my participation I said instruction, training, riding, handling, leading, Veterinary assistant of personal horse or other horses and Ferrier assistant whether caused by negligence of release or otherwise by Cool Hills Ranch. _____(Initial here)

5. INDEMNITY / LIABILITY RELEASE BY PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF MINOR CHILD OR LEGAL WARD:
